

## Advanced Wilderness Survival and Primitive Living

*"This course is a continuation of the introductory course and meant to give students a more in depth perspective of primitive living. This course is meant to transition the student towards long term wilderness living, allowing them to shed the dependence of modern society and begin the transition to self sustainability. Long term shelter and food options will be looked at in detail as well as tool construction and use in addition to transport and a concise study of fire by multiple methods".*

Course is approx. 3 days in length (48hr practicum)
